The tender process has not been finalised / awarded to a service provider for the leave system. Therefore, in order for continuance we require extension for a period of two months in order to be compliant with the leave.	On Friday, 07 July 2023, the fire vehicle in Caledon lost both rear tyres while on call. This vehicle is the only structural vehicle at Caledon station. Swellendam vehicle also lost a tyre and was without a spare. In the light of protest actions planned in two locations in the Overberg, it was imperative to ensure that we have the maximum number of vehicles on run. The tyre tender is not in place yet and permission was requested from the MM telephonically and then per whatsapp to do a deviation in order to procure three tyres.	The tender is currently in the evaluation process and will be awarded in the next 2 weeks. The three depos will not have security guards for the month of August and will be vulnerable for possible thefts. The process will be concluded, and the tender will be awarded in the month August 2023.	On Saturday, 12 August 2023, a vehicle towing a 1000lt fuel trailer was involved in an accident on the R316 between Caledon and Bredasdorp. The accident caused the trailer to rupture and spill hazardous material along the road and road verge. Fire and rescue services attended to the scene and reported the hazardous spill at approximately 11h00, that was spreading along the stormwater furrow parallel to the road and affecting the

The tender was awarded, and two objections received which are currently managed by an independent and impartial person. There is no timeframe indicated for the completion of the objections. Without security guards the depots are vulnerable to criminal activities. It is therefore requested that the current services be extended for the month of September to ensure sufficient time to manage the objections.
