One additional person, Ms. Tamlin Engel, was appointed on 11 September 2024 to assist with the new PPR Regulations process.

Ms. D. Kapot-Witbooi has completed 24 unit standards; however, HR has indicated that she needs to complete two (2) additional unit standards of the MMC training. Messrs. Jacques Harmse and Jaco Leonard are currently in the process of completing their MMC training. It is crucial for staff members to receive continuous internal training on supply chain management processes.
