PERIOD APRIL – JUNE 2025	Reasons for Deviation	The second secon	The vehicle for which the deviation is required is Isuzu Fire Truck still under warranty with Isuzu. The gearbox may be faulty and is covered under the warranty, but the clutch is also faulty / worn and may affect the gearbox. The clutch is however not covered by the warranty. The clutch needs to be repaired by Isuzu so that the warranty on the gearbox is not affected. Only once the clutch is repaired, can it be ascertained if the gearbox is faulty and repaired under warranty. Thus, in summary, the main reason for the deviation is that Isuzu must repair the vehicle to ensure the warranty is not affected and secondary the vehicle is already stripped to find the fault and sending it to additional Isuzu dealers in other towns will be impractical and costly. To note that Isuzu Fuzion Swellendam is not one of our suppliers on the T44-2022/23 tender.
